This fact sheet tells you about the kind of advice that council tenants can get from the Energy Advice Centre:

- How you can save energy – changing habits to save energy

- Energy saving devices – (such as power downs)
- Social tariffs – a discounted price that is available to a small number of customers from some of the energy companies. You must be spending 10% of your income on heating/fuel bills.
- Fuel debt charities (If you are a British Gas or EDF customer meeting the eligibility criteria. These schemes are often subject to change)
- Are you eligible for winter fuel payment or cold weather payments
